The important work of Mediterranean Hope, sponsored by the Reformed Churches in Italy, including the Waldensians/Methodists, continues, and we have a link with this organisation. Fiona Kendall, a Scottish Lawyer, is now working with Mediterranean Hope in Rome, as a legal advisor and administrator. She was able to share information about her ongoing work, with the advising and re-settling of immigrants who had arrived in the South of Italy particularly in the island of Lampedusa, on a Zoom conference with supporters from the World Mission Group of Liberton Kirk, on 23 September 2021. On 3 October 2022, the ninth anniversary was reached, of the tides of migrants arriving in the little island of Lampedusa. This was a sad anniversary, as during that time, 368 deaths were recorded.

We were very pleased to welcome in May of this year, as delegate to the General Assembly of the Church of Scotland for 2022, Pastora Anne Zell, presently the Pastor of the Waldensian Church at Como. She was able to attend a number of sessions of the Assembly, and had a meeting with supporters of the Society at Liberton, members of the World Mission Group of Liberton Kirk.

In 2022 Servizio Cristiano, in Riesi, Sicily, celebrates its 60th anniversary. The Centre, which is a place of outreach and training, was founded by Pastor Tullio Vinay. Pastor Vinay was the founder and moving force in the Agape centre, at Prali in the Waldensian Valleys, which was inaugurated after the Second World War as a place of reconciliation. Some years ago the present director of Servizio Cristiano, Gianluca Fiusco, was able to visit Scotland and speak to supporters of the Society about the valuable ongoing work in the community there.
